#### **Don Bosco Solidarity COVID-19 Relief in India**

The Don Bosco Network created the Don Bosco Solidarity COVID-19 Relief campaign to streamline resource mobilisation and action towards COVID-19 relief in India. The Don Bosco network has been in action since the imposing of the first national lockdown in March 2020—mobilising resources, procuring essential supplies such as food and sanitary items, producing masks, packing and distributing aid packages to the vulnerable and marginalised people across India. This has been through the concerted efforts of the 11 Don Bosco Planning and Development Organisations (PDOs) and their constituent local partners. This brief interim report lays out Don Bosco Network's interventions and outreach for COVID-19 relief as of July 2020.

#### **Relief interventions:**

- 1. Distribution of rations kits
- 2. Distribution of cooked food
- 3. Distribution of mini meals to migrants on the road
- 4. Distribution of cookies, cakes, nutrition kits, baby kits, chapatis, yoghurt, water
- 5. Distribution of sanitary kits
- 6. Distribution of masks
- 7. Counselling services
- 8. Cash transfers/ Cash for work
- 9. Contribution to Government Relief Funds

#### **Target groups:**

- 1. Migrants, slum dwellers, poorest of the poor, transgenders, daily-wagers and other vulnerable families
- 2. Elderly people without support
- 3. Stranded individuals
- 4. Visually challenged
- 5. People living with HIV/AIDS (PLHA)


#### **Process:**

- Procuring prior permissions and vehicle permits from the relevant authorities
- Organising security from the police and/or other government officials
- Mobilisation of volunteers
- Adherence to proper safety measures as per government guidelines
- Documentation of beneficiaries as requested by the sponsors/donors
- · Dignified distribution of aid to beneficiaries







#### **State-wise Overall Beneficiaries**




#### **Beneficiaries of Ration kits**



#### **Beneficiaries of Cooked Food**




### **Beneficiaries of Face Masks**
